## **Autumn Term**

- Phonics Twinkl Level 1.
- Handles books carefully.
- Shows interest in illustrations and print in books and print in the environment.
- Enjoys an increasing range of books.
- Listens to and joins in with stories and poems.
- Is able to recall favourite stories, rhymes and songs.
- Repeats words or phrases from familiar stories.
- Enjoys rhyming and rhythmic activities.
- Shows an awareness of rhyme and alliteration.
- Distinguishes between the different marks they make and sometimes gives meaning to them.
- Shows preference for a dominant hand.
- Developing pencil grip.
- Gives meaning to marks made.
- Recognises familiar words and signs such as own name and advertising logos.

## **Spring Term**

- Continuing with Phonics Twinkl Level 1.
  - Understand the five key concepts about print:
    - print has meaning
    - print can have different purposes
    - we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom
    - the names of the different parts of a book-page sequencing.
  - Develop phonological awareness:
    - spot and suggest rhymes
    - count or clap syllables in a word
    - recognise words with the same initial sound
  - Engage in conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
  - Write some or all of their name.
  - Developing letter formation.
  - Developing pencil grip.

## **Summer Term**

- Continuing with Phonics Twinkl Level 1.
- Discrete teaching of Level 2 in preparation for Reception.
- Understanding print has meaning.
- Understanding print can have different purposes.
- Developing knowledge of the names of the different parts of a book.
- Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing.

- Write some or all of their name.
- Write some letters accurately.
- Continuing to develop their phonological awareness.
- Discrete teaching of letter names and sounds.
- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
