Mental Health week

Mental Health Awareness Week was a good opportunity to explore the theme 'movement'. In our assembly, led by Megan Wood, our Educational Wellbeing Practitioner, we discussed the importance of not only looking after our mental health, but also our physical health through doing things like exercise and how this can have an impact on how we feel- and how the two correlate. We also learnt about PMRs (progressive muscle relaxants) where we can focus on different parts of the body which can hold tension and that by clenching the muscle, it can help to relax the area, e.g.jaw, shoulder.
